## A one day visit to view 'the ship that changed the world'

Launched in 1843 she was called 'the greatest experiment since the Creation'. By combining size, power and innovative technology, Brunel created a ship that changed history. His vision made the SS Great Britain the template for all modern ships. As well as a guided tour of the ship and lunch on board we will visit the 'Being Brunel' Museum which comprises six galleries and some 150 of Brunel's personal artefacts that demonstrate significant insights into Brunel's influence on the world.



The overall design is set to evoke the atmosphere of the Great Exhibition of 1851 – which was a celebration of Victorian wonder and invention.
